- RS National Assembly representatives still have not adopted 12th session agenda
- RS Government withdraws seven legal acts from RS National Assembly procedure

- June and May disability benefits not paid out on 7 September as planned
- April pensions will be paid between 10 and 15 September – Pension and Disability Insurance Fund Director Svetozar Mihajlovic

- Ganic statement accusing RS of obstructing return process reveals his political platform – RS Government PR Office
