At the invitation of Greek deputies in the European Parliament, the RS President, Biljana Plavsic, today left for Greece for a few days. Plavsic was warmly welcomed at Athens Airport by senior Greek officials and representatives of a Greek "Caravan of Solidarity" that is the organiser of this visit. Plavsic expressed gratitude for Greek support and recalled a very successful and long-lasting cooperation between the RS and Greece during the war and in the post-war period.
