Headlines

- Talks between the RS and FRY Governments on resolving the problems after the cessation of payment operations are scheduled for tomorrow
- RS NA session to be held on November 30 in Banja Luka
- On the second day of his visit to Srpsko Sarajevo President Poplasen stated he would support the policy of balanced development of all parts of the RS
- After three months' break, Iraq arms control inspectors back in the field

A RS Government delegation consisting of the PM Milorad Dodik, the Finance Minister Novak Kondic and the general manager of the RS Development Bank Ranko Travar is travelling to Belgrade tomorrow to discuss problems caused by the FRY Government's decision to stop payment operations with the RS.
