SRT correspondent from Belgrade reports about last night's NATO air strikes. At least 10 people were killed and 16 wounded in the bombing of a refugee camp near Djakovica. SPS headquarters were hit in Business Center building Usce.

U.S. Secretary of State, Madelaine Albright testified before Congress regarding the request for additional funding for Kosovo action.

Russian Special Envoy, Chernomyrdin is likely to come to Belgrade in order to try to find peaceful solution for the Kosovo crisis.- Russian media report

Tony Blair stated that he wants Russia to take part in solving the Kosovo crisis and that he would soon meet with Chernomyrdin.

American aircraft carrier "Enterprise" followed by three battle ships passed through the Suez heading to join <u>NATO</u> forces.

Two French soldiers were hurt when people of Kuceviste (near Skopje) stoned ${\tt NATO}$ convoy.

Bulgarian Prime Minister departed for Brussels where he is to sign permission for air corridors for NATO.

NATO Spokesperson, Jamie Shea said that NATO attacks are continuing with success. General Marani, who explained the latest NATO hits, also attended press conference. CMDR. Maltiniti presented the humanitarian situation in the region.

The Kosovo Executive Board gave Kosovo Albanians, who returned to their homes in Podujevo and Istok, humanitarian and medical aid.

Petar Djokic said, after the consultative meeting, that the RS NA special session would continue on Tuesday, April 27 at noon.
