The recent elections and the current situation in the RS were the topics of separate meetings between the Russian Ambassador to BiH, Philip Sidorsky, and the SRS president, Nikola Poplasen, SPS RS president, Zivko Radisic, and SDS president, Nikola Kalinic. "We talked about the implementation of the DA

with Mr. Poplasen. Russia, as one of the members of the Contact Group, is especially interested in its implementation" Sidorsky said.

Philip Sidorsky and Radisic talked about the implementation of the DA after announcement of the official election results. They also exchanged opinions on the situation in Kosovo. Radisic stated that the stability of the RS, i.e. BiH, depends on the situation in Kosovo.

This meeting discussed the situation on Kosovo, too. Kalinic expressed the hope that the situation in Kosovo would be resolved by dialogue.
