"The Serb Radical Party thinks that Milorad Dodik should not, under any circumstances, be nominated the PM designate, and that Dragan Kalinic should return his mandate, since he failed to provide parliamentary support for his proposed Government", said the SRS acting President, Mirko Blagojevic, adding that Dodik's Government was very detrimental to the RS. He also said new consultations should follow, and 'Sloga' Coalition should propose another person for the PM.
