President of the RS, Biljana Plavsic, met with the Supervisor for Brcko, Robert Farrand, today in Banja Luka. The meeting centred on the situation in Brcko, and Farrand said that President Plavsic was misinformed about the incident that occurred during the registration and marking of Muslim houses in the city. Farrand stated that those houses were not occupied by Serbs, but were destroyed houses.

Speaker of the RS NA, Petar Djokic, and Supervisor Farrand discussed the situation in Brcko at their meeting today. The Speaker also said that the regular session of the RS NA is delayed due to technical reasons, but announced an extraordinary session that will be held at the request of the group of SDS representatives.

Remains of the late Dr. Milan Kovacevic were brought to Prijedor today. The FRY Minister of Justice addressed a letter to Gabriela Kirk McDonald, President of the [ICTY](#), stating that every court is responsible for the fate of imprisoned persons until passing of sentence that goes into effect.
