President of the RS, Biljana Plavsic, talked in Banja Luka today with the newly appointed Head of the UNICEF Mission and Special Representative for Former Yugoslavia, Steven Allen. They discussed implementation of the Convention on Children's Rights and the President promised significant assistance to the UNICEF programme. The RS PM, Milorad Dodik, met with the Director of the <u>World</u> <u>Bank</u> in BiH, Rory O'Sullivan.
