- BiH national, with Law Degree or Criminology Degree from a university in Bosnia and Herzegovina or elsewhere. Alternatively, a student in the last year of legal or criminological studies.
- Previous experience with or exposure to the criminal laws and criminal procedural laws currently in force in Bosnia and Herzegovina is highly desirable.
- · Ability to interact with national and international experts.
- · Personal commitment to peace implementation and antifraud and corruption work in Bosnia and Herzegovina.
- Ability to work well in independently and in a team.
- Excellent command of oral and written English and good writing skills.
- Excellent computer skills.
