827 (1993) of
25 May 1993,*

*Having regard to Article 16 (4) of the Statute of the
International*

Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for
Serious Violations of
International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of
the Former
Yugoslavia since 1991 (S/25704),

Having considered the nomination by the Secretary-General of
Mr. Richard J. Goldstone for the position of Prosecutor of the
International
Tribunal,

Appoints Mr. Richard J. Goldstone as Prosecutor of the
International
Tribunal.
